

When should I apply for residence?

- As soon as you have confirmation that your application has been received by the post-secondary institution.

NOTE: If you applied on-line, you should have confirmation within 48 hours. Paper applications can take up to 4 weeks or longer to process. Most institutions will refund your residence application fee if you choose not to attend their institution.

***You need to check and make sure this is the case. ***

▶ **When should I apply?**

Check application dates at your post secondary institution. For non-competitive programs, early application is advised to secure a seat in a program.

NOTE: University deadlines vary and many colleges fill spaces throughout the year. To qualify for many scholarships, you will need to apply early.

How do I know which post secondary institution is right for me?

- It is highly recommended that you attend an Open House. Information about Open Houses can be found on university and college web sites and on the Calendar of the www.cc.wolfcreek.ab.ca website.
- Students and parents are encouraged to attend the LCHS Post Secondary Open House, date TBA each Fall.
- If you miss an Open House, most institutions offer other opportunities to visit. Check the post-secondary web-sites.

▶ **How should I apply?**

If you are planning to attend a public post-secondary institution in Alberta, you should use ApplyAlberta.

What is ApplyAlberta?

ApplyAlberta is an online application and transcript transfer system that anyone can use to apply to undergraduate programs at one or more of Alberta's public post-secondary institutions.

How it will help me...

You only need to enter your personal and academic information once - it is transferred automatically to each institution you choose.

Authorizing institutions to request transcript transfers saves you time and money.

You **will not be charged** a fee for transcripts transferred through ApplyAlberta.

Check the Apply Alberta site to see which institutions use this service. If the Alberta post secondary institution you wish to attend is not on this list, you will need to apply directly through that institution.

In that case, you will need to request an official transcript through your MyPass account. Sign up at myPass.alberta.ca. This request can be sent at any time and Alberta Education will send the transcript to your institution at the time requested by you.

If you are applying for a post secondary institution outside the province of Alberta, you will need to go to their website and find the application form. It is highly recommended that you attend an open house or visit the institution prior to attending.

If you are applying outside of Canada, you must research and talk to an academic advisor from the institution of your choice. You must rely on their knowledge to help with you with all the paper work you will need to become an international student.
